




<u>PubMed XML Export Plugin</u>: Export article metadata in PubMed XML format for indexing in MEDLINE.

<u>Portico Export Plugin</u>: This plugin may be used to export your journal content for inclusion in the Portico digital preservation service. Content maybe downloaded manually to your local computer for later delivery to Portico, or may be sent directly to your account on the Portico FTP server.

QuickSubmit Plugin: One-step submission plugin

<u>DataCite Export/Registration Plugin</u>: Export or register issue, article, galley and supplementary file metadata in DataCite format.




